- **Short description:**

A short intensive seminar on theory in landscape architecture by means of relating texts, projects and interpretations into an overall framework of design knowledge in landscape architecture.

- **Goals of the seminar:**

- To give an short overview of the state of the art in theory of landscape architecture with a focus on space typology
- Learning to analyse texts in relation to design projects by field visits, analysis of plans and relate them into a coherent analytical framework
- Learning to evaluate, interpret and discuss the theoretical aspects of space concepts and design in landscape architecture

- **Teaching modes:**

- Lectures
- Field visits
- Studio work
- Presentations, intermediate and final

- **References will all be available in digital form. There will be the mandatory reading requirements for each lecture. Next to that there will be a more general reading list of background literature. As overall references we will use Motloch (2001) as a general background for landscape architecture, Lynch (1981) and Cross (2006) + history??.**

- **Marks and grading**

Grading will be done on series of explicit criteria that have been defined before the start of the seminar. Criteria will be based on the reading of texts (handouts in digital form), field visits and analysis of projects, discussion during the presentation and the ability to relate the three. A notebook is mandatory for the entire seminar and will be graded separately. The final project will be a summary of all work done during the seminar. Note that all work will be done on the A3 format. You will have to turn in your work both in paper and in digital form (all A3, 300 dpi)

Since the seminar is very short, absence and coming late cannot be accepted. We start always in time.
